MME Awards nominees added to ESNS23 line-up

ESNS (Eurosonic Noorderslag), the key exchange for emerging European music talent announces that all fifteen nominees will play at ESNS 2023.

Yesterday evening, the fifteen nominees for the Music Moves Europe Awards were announced at the *MaMa Music Convention and Festival* in Paris. Today, ESNS announces all fifteen nominees will play at ESNS 2023 on Thursday, January 19.

The annual awards are designed to accelerate the international careers of upcoming European acts. Former winners of the awards include; Stromae, Alyona Alyona, Rosalía, Dua Lipa, Mezzerg, Blanks, Ladaniva, Meskerem Mees and Christine and the Queens.

The MME Awards are awarded annually at ESNS. At ESNS23 the awards will be presented on Thursday, January 19.

ESNS (Eurosonic Noorderslag) is the key exchange for emerging European music talent, with a proven track record of helping to break new acts on the international music scene, with now well-known names such as Altin Gün, Arlo Parks, Alyona Alyona, Daði Freyr, Dua Lipa, Fontaines D.C., Hinds, Go_A, girl in red, Meduza,

Meskerem Mees, MYD, Priya Ragu, Pip Blom, Pongo, Sigrid and Wet Leg. Each January, ESNS showcases 350 emerging European artists to over 40,000 visitors. The festival and conference attract over 4,000 music industry professionals, including 400 international festivals. By day, the front-running conference hosts over 150 panel discussions, interviews, keynotes and more that take on urgent subjects and the need for social change in the music industry. By night, European acts perform across 40 locations in the heart of Groningen from Wednesday to Friday, and Saturday presents upcoming Dutch artists in concert venue De Oosterpoort.
